

2015 State PAC Nominations

1. John S. Edwards, a Democratic member of the Virginia State Senate since 1993, represents the 21st Senate District, covering Roanoke. He was patron or co-patron (2001) of bills to establish enhanced staffing guidelines for nursing homes introduced in 2001, 2004, 2005 and 2007, one of which (SB 715) passed the Senate in 2005. In 2015, he introduced legislation (SB 708) to allow absentee voting for persons 65 or older, one of two 2015 VFC State Plan issues that passed the Senate. He won the last election with only 55.87% of the vote. He is a member of Courts of Justice, Privileges and Elections and Transportation Committees. A \$500 donation is recommended. **Nominated by Tom Hart, LC, Ch 737 Fairfax**

Kaye Kory has been a member of the Virginia General Assembly House of Delegates since 2010. She has a record of constituent support that dovetails with the goals and objectives of NARFE. In the 2014 session, she was a House sponsor of legislation in support of three VFC Legislative Agenda items: HB 37: Senior Absentee Voting; HB 314: Income Tax Subtraction; and, HB 315: Incapacitated Adults, which was the subject of several hearings with testimony by members of the VFC. Although none of the aforementioned legislation was successful, our concerns as Seniors and NARFE members were introduced to the General Assembly – it is a start.

In the 2015 session, she again sponsored HB 314, Income tax subtraction, (which had been carried over from the 2014 sessions), and was a House co-sponsor of Senate Bills 708 and 719 pertaining to Senior and Absentee Voting.

Delegate Kory has participated in several Chapter 1159 meeting events. Her record clearly indicates she will be supportive of NARFE issues and positions in the future. She is deserving of our financial support.
